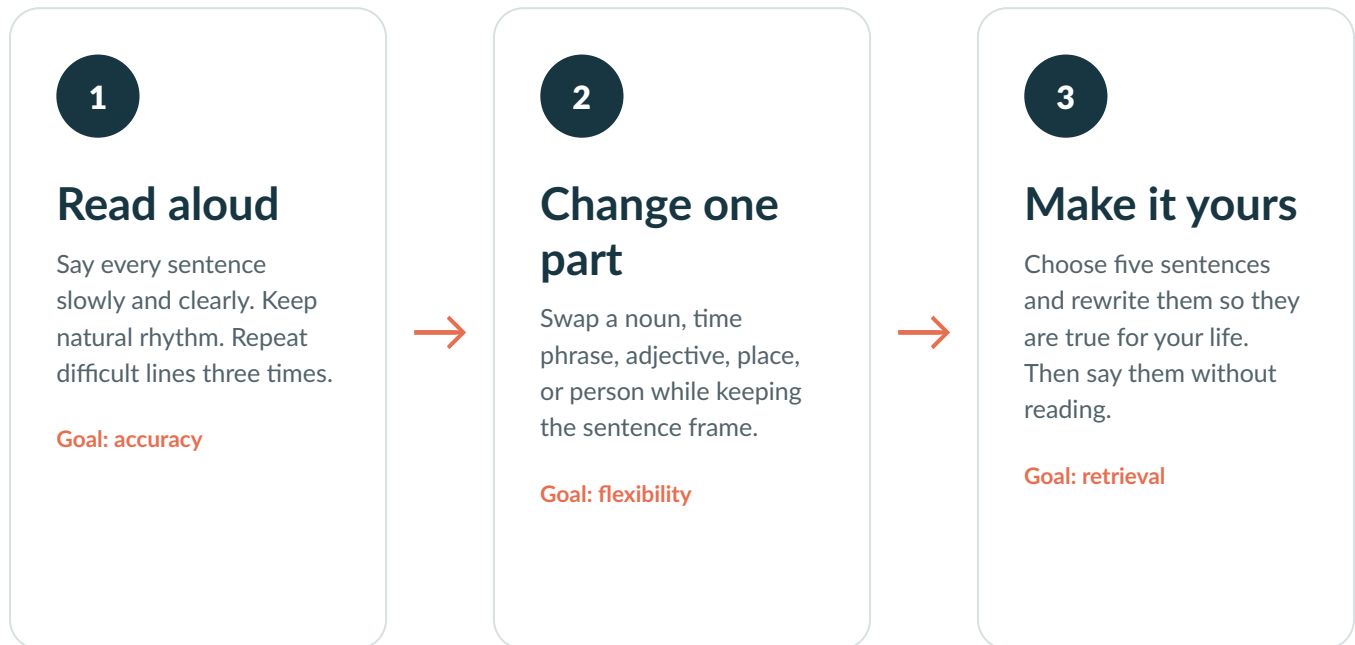

The 3-pass fluency loop

Each unit has 50 sentences. Do not race through them once. Use three passes so the same sentence becomes recognition, production, and personal speech.



DEMONSTRATION

Pack sentence: I usually check my phone in the morning.

Change one part: I usually check my calendar in the morning.

Personalize: I usually make tea before I check my phone.

Common mistake: silently reading hundreds of lines. Silent reading builds recognition. Spoken fluency needs audible retrieval, controlled variation, and repetition across several days.
